Urinary Symptom Questionnaire for Neurogenic Bladder-Indwelling Catherization (USQNB-IDC)

ACTIONABLE	URINE QUALITY
□ Autonomic Dysreflexia (AD)	□ Worse-smelling urine
□ Feeling feverish	□ Darker urine
□ Abdominal/ suprapubic pain	□ Cloudier/sediment in urine
□ Increased tone/spasticity (not bladder spasms)	Total "Urine Quality" Symptoms
□ Bladder spasm frequency/discomfort	
□ Sweating	CONSTITUTIONAL
□ Flushing of the chest, neck, or face	 Discharge, redness, or sensitivity around catheter site
Total "Actionable" Symptoms	□ Increase or decrease from your usual blood pressure
	□ Diarrhea
	□ Numbness, tingling in your extremities
BLADDER	□ Sense of burning in the extremities or
□ Blood in urine	throughout the body
□ Blood clots in urine	□ Increase in fatigue, lethargy, or
□ Urinary urgency	weakness
□ Incontinence/ Urine leakage	 □ Generalized abdominal discomfort or bloating
Total "Bladder" Symptoms	□ Back pain
	□ Pain below the level of injury
	□ Irritability or mental slowing/confusion
